		and posture based on rider's ability.
Level 2	Round-the-World (4-way sit)	Judges will be looking at balance, position
		and posture as competitors ride facing all
		four ways, based on rider's ability
Level 3	Round-the-World/Trot	Judges will be looking at balance, position
		and posture as competitors ride facing all
		four ways, as well as balance and position
		while performing a sitting trot with
		assistance
Level 4	Reining Class – walk only, with	Judges will be looking at the rider's ability
	assistance	to steer horse through a series of
		obstacles. The riders may be assisted by
		side walkers to use their reins. Riders must
		have a handler.
Level 5	Reining Class – walk only	Judges will be looking at rider's ability to
		steer horse through a series of obstacles.
		Rider may have a handler but must be in
		control of their horse.
Level 6	Reining Class – with trot	Judges will be looking at rider's ability to
		steer horse through a series of obstacles.
,		Rider may have a handler but must be in
		control of their horse. Riders will also be
		asked to perform a jumping position at a
		walk and either a sitting or posting trot.
Level 7	Under Saddle - Walk/Trot	Under saddle, riders will be asked to
		perform a series of tasks to test their
		balance, seat position and control of the
		horse. Riders may have side walkers but
		NO HANDLER.
Level 8	Under Saddle - Walk/Trot/Canter	Under saddle, riders will be asked to
		perform a series of tasks to test their
		balance, seat position and control of the
•		horse. Riders may not have side walkers or
		handler.
Level 9	Dressage Class – Under Saddle	Under saddle, riders will be asked to
		perform a basic dressage test and be
		judged on accuracy, the horse's quality of
		movement & horse's obedience. Riders
		may have side walkers but NO HANDLER.
